## Secretary's Report


### Road Closures

- **Newlands Road will be closed between Jackton Road and No 68 Newlands Road** from Monday 20 July until March 2022 for the upgrading/reconstruction and installation of public utility apparatus on Newlands Road associated with the Community Growth Area. Access to residential properties will be maintained at all times from one direction. Diversion via Jackton Road, Eaglesham Road, Greenhills Road, Newlands Road and vice versa.
- **A726 at College Milton will be closed from the Queensway at its junction with B761 West Mains Road (McDonald's roundabout) to B764 Eaglesham Road junction (KFC roundabout)** for resurfacing works by AMEY SW from 8pm Thursday 27 May to 6am Friday 28 May and daily from Monday 31 May to Wednesday 2 June (9.30am to 3pm). Eastbound traffic will be diverted via A726 Queensway, B761 West Mains Road, Churchill Avenue, A726 Queensway. Westbound traffic will be diverted via A726 Queensway, B764 Eaglesham Road, Redwood Drive, Glasgow Southern Orbital (A726), A726/A727 Phillipshill.
- **B764 Eaglesham Road is closed at Hairmyres Roundabout** from Monday 5 July to Friday 9 July for carriageway resurfacing. Alternative route via Westwood Road, Westwood Hill, Lickprivick Road and Greenhills Road.
- **Braehead Road is closed between no 2 and no 2A** from 9.30am to 6pm on Wednesday 2 June for Scottish Water manhole repairs. Alternative route via Thornton Road and Peel Road.
- **Peel Park Place is closed from A726 Queensway** to its termination for overnight work (6pm to 6am) from Monday 17 May to Friday 21 May for carriageway surfacing. There is no alternative route.

## Deer on the Road

A community member has reported two deer killed by vehicles on Peel Rd. While speed is likely a contributing factor, South Lanarkshire Council is being asked to assess the problem and if a deer or wild animal sign can be erected as a motorist warning.



Some helpful information from the AA, and what to do if you hit and injure a deer.

1. Accidents involving deer peak in May, October and November.
2. The worst times of day are around sunrise and sunset to midnight.
3. Be extra vigilant where you see 'deer' or 'wild animal' road signs.
4. A deer can appear almost instantly – nature makes them hard to see and they don't follow the green cross code.
5. Use your high-beam headlights (without dazzling other drivers) when it's dark, but dip them if you see a deer, otherwise it may freeze in your path.
6. Don't over-react or swerve excessively. It's safer to continue on your normal track rather than swerving or braking hard to try to avoid a deer.
7. Bear in mind that if you do swerve and miss a deer (or any other animal), but hit something else, it will be very hard to prove that the deer ever existed.
8. If you do hit a deer, try to stop somewhere safe.
9. Report the accident to the police – they'll contact someone who can help the injured deer.
